

**RESOLUTION NO. 7-24**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CONNOQUENESSING,  
COUNTY OF BUTLER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,  
AMENDING THE PUBLIC RECORDS POLICY CONCERNING  
ANONYMOUS REQUESTERS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Township is desirous of amending its procedures for requesting, processing and providing public records concerning anonymous requesters; and

**WHEREAS**, § 702 of Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Right-to-Know Law, Act 3 of 2008§ 66.1 et seq., gives agencies discretion to choose if they want to provide records to anonymous requesters.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors, to the extent permitted by law, the Township shall not accept anonymous requests submitted pursuant to the Pennsylvania Right-to-Know Law.
