RESOLUTION NO. 7-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CONNOQUENESSING, COUNTY OF BUTLER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE PUBLIC RECORDS POLICY CONCERNING ANONYMOUS REQUESTERS.

WHEREAS, the Township is desirous of amending its procedures for requesting, processing and providing public records concerning anonymous requesters; and

WHEREAS, § 702 of Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Right-to-Know Law, Act 3 of 2008§ 66.1 et seq., gives agencies discretion to choose if they want to provide records to anonymous requesters.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors, to the extent permitted by law, the Township shall not accept anonymous requests submitted pursuant to the Pennsylvania Right-to-Know Law.
